SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 569, L.D.1709, Bill, "AN ACT
Establishing a County Records Board."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first underlined
sentence of that part designated "§347." of section 1 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'There is created and established a County Records Board to
consist of 5 members: Four persons to be appointed by the Governor
with advice and consent of the Council for a term of 3 years; one
of whom shall be a county commissioner; one of whom shall be a
register of deeds; one of whom shall be a register of probate; and
one of whom shall be experienced in real estate title examinations;
and a 5th person who shall be the State Archivist and shall serve
as chairman.'


Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§348."
of section 1 by inserting at the end of the 2nd sentence, before
the period, the following: ',and shall follow the standards for
the making of records set forth in Title 33, chapter 11, subchapter
II'
