SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1416, L.D. 1710, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Disposal of Septic Tank or Cesspool Waste."


Amend said Bill in the 11th line of that part designated "\$4104."
(same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "\$200" and
inserting in place thereof the following underlined figure: '\$50'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the next to the
last sentence in that part designated "\$4104."

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "\$4105."
by striking out in the last line of the first paragraph (the last 2
lines of the first paragraph in L.D.) the following words and figure:
"not less than \$500 nor" and inserting in place thereof the following
underlined word: 'not'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will reduce the cost of a license to a more
reasonable amount. It would further eliminate any dedication of revenue
raised from such license fees and eliminate minimum fines in favor of
judicial discretion within a maximum limit.
