COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1313, L.D. 1723, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Minimum Wages for Students Employed at Summer Camps."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of paragraph F and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'F. Those employees who are counsellors or junior
counsellors at summer camps for boys and girls; and
employees of ~~said~~ such nonprofit summer camps, other than
counsellors or junior counsellors, who are under the
age of 19 and are regularly enrolled in an educational
institution or are on vacation therefrom;'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to exempt nonprofit camps
as to student employees other than counsellors or junior counsellors.
