COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1313, L.D. 1723, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Minimum Wages for Students Employed at Summer Camps."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of paragraph F and inserting in place thereof the following:

'F. Those employees who are counsellors or junior counsellors at summer camps for boys and girls; and employees of said such nonprofit summer camps, other than counsellors or junior counsellors, who are under the age of 19 and are regularly enrolled in an educational institution or are on vacation therefrom;'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to exempt nonprofit camps as to student employees other than counsellors or junior counsellors.
