SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1423, L. D. 1747, Bill, "AN ACT to Raise the Classification of Certain Surface Waters in the Town of Scarborough."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th, 7th and 8th lines (5th and 6th lines in L. D.) the following: "where longitude 70°-16'-40" crosses the Scarboro mainland (just north of Higgins Beach)" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'where-longitude-70°-16'-40"-crosses-the-Scarboro-mainland-(just-north-of-Higgins-Beach) on the mainland directly north of cool rock'
