AN ACT Providing Aroostook County Funds to Implement Food Stamp Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Funds to Aroostook County to implement food stamp program. Aroostook County shall appropriate \$67,000 to implement the county's share of its food stamp program. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title.
