COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " / " to H. P. 1344, L. D. 1778, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Certain Disclosures in the Solicitation of Charitable Contributions."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 22, § 3151, sub-§ 4, amended. The last sentence of subsection 4 of section 3151 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

A bona fide officer or employee of a charitable organization shall not be deemed a professional fund raiser <u>unless his</u> <u>salary or other compensation is computed on the basis of funds</u> to be raised or actually raised.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in that part designated "<u>§ 3155.</u>" (same in L. D.) by striking out all of the first underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'It shall be a violation of this chapter for a professional solicitor or professional fund raiser to solicit funds for a charitable purpose from a prospective donor in the State of Maine without fully disclosing to the prospective donor the estimated cost of the solicitation, where less than 70% of the amount donated will be expended for the specific charitable purpose.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " 4" to H. P. 1344, L. D. 1778

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end before the Statement of Fact (same in L. D.) the following:

'Sec. 4. R. S., T. 22, § 3156, additional. Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3156 to read as follows:

§ 3156. Violation as unfair trade practice

Any violation of this chapter shall constitute a violation of Title 5, chapter 10, the Unfair Trade Practices Act.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 and 2 to be sections 2 and 3.

Statement of Fact

The purposes of the amendments are to eliminate ambiguities in the original draft and to make any violation a violation of the Unfair Trade Practices Act for enforcement purposes.
