## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A " to H.P. 1349, L.D. 1782, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Sunday Sale of Beer in Restaurants and Tayerns."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause, the underlined abbreviation and figure: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 8th line after the amending clause (6th and 7th lines of L.D.) the underlined words "state-wide special" and inserting in place thereof, the following: 'general'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the beginning of the first line of the 2nd paragraph after the amending clause (same in L.D.) the underlined figure "12" and inserting in place thereof, the following: '14'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 2nd line of the 3rd paragraph after the amending clause (first line in L.D.) the underlined word "Electors" and inserting in place thereof, the following: 'Subsequently, electors'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 3rd and 5th lines of the 3rd paragraph after the amending clause (same in L.D.) the underlined figure " $\underline{12}$ " and inserting in place thereof, the following: ' $\underline{14}$ '

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact, the following:

'Sec. 2. R.S., T. 28, §101, sub-§14, additional. Section 101 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 49 of the public laws of 1967, and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 14 to read as follows:

14. Shall this municipality or unincorporated place authorize the sale on Sunday of malt liquor for consumption on the premises by taverns, class A taverns and restaurants, other than class A licensees, who are permitted to make such sales during the rest of the week?
