COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1389, L.D. 1799, Bill, "AN ACT Repealing all Exemptions under Minimum Wage Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following new Title: 'AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Executive Individuals under Minimum Wage Law.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 26, § 663, sub-§3, ¶ K, amended. Paragraph K of subsection 3 of section 663 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

K. Any individual employed in a bona fide executive, administrative, or professional capacity, and who is paid on a salary basis of not less than \$90 \$125 weekly ~~for one year starting October 15, 1967, and thereafter not less than \$100 weekly.~~

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to raise the applicable financial salary category for individuals employed in a bona fide executive, administrative or professional capacity.
