COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1389, L.D. 1799, Bill, "AN ACT Repealing all Exemptions under Minimum Wage Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following new Title: 'AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Executive Individuals under Minimum Wage Law.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 26, § 663, sub-§3, ¶ K, amended. Paragraph K of subsection 3 of section 663 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

K. Any individual employed in a bona fide executive, administrative, or professional capacity, and who is paid on a salary basis of not less than \$90 \$125 weekly for-one year-starting-October-15,-1967,-and-thereafter-not-less than-\$100-weekly.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to raise the applicable financial salary category for individuals employed in a bona fide executive, administrative or professional capacity.
