AN ACT Repealing all Exemptions under Minimum Wage Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 663, sub-§ 3, repealed and replaced. Subsection 3 of section 663 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

3. **Employee.** "Employee," any individual employed or permitted to work by an employer;
