HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 586, L. D. 1804, RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Providing for Regulation
of Municipal Borrowing by the Legislature.

Amend said Resolution by striking out in the 9th, 10th and
11th lines (8th, 9th and 10th lines/ ^{of L. D.)} the underlined words "and
quasi-municipal corporations providing public services to or
within the boundaries of any municipal corporation"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete quasi-municipal corporations because a mandatory Constitutional amendment which applies to water districts and sewer districts that serve more than one municipality will seriously disrupt that water district or sewer district from issuing bonds. Without a Constitutional amendment the Legislature still has the power to regulate the debt limit for quasi-municipal corporations.
