# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Designating a Commemorative Day in Remembrance of Martin Luther King, Jr.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 1, § 115, additional.** Title 1 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 115 to read as follows:

#### § 115. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day

January 15th of each year shall be designated as Martin Luther King, Jr. Day and the Governor may annually issue a proclamation inviting and urging the people of the State of Maine to observe the day in schools and other suitable places with appropriate ceremony and activity.
