SENATE AMENDMENT A " to H. P. 1382, L. D. 1812, Bill, "AN ACT to Organize the Unorganized and Deorganized Territories of the State and to Provide for Management of the Public Peserved Lands."

Amend said Bill, insection 15 by striking out in the 15th line of subsection 3 (14th line in L. D.) of that part designated "<u>\$4162.</u>" the underlined word "<u>plans</u>" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'plan'

Further

Amend said Bill in section 15 by striking out all of subsection 5 of that part designated "\$4162."

Further amend said Bill in section 15 by renumbering subsections 6 and 7 of that part designated "84162." to be subsections 5 and 6.

Further amend said Bill in section 16 by striking out all of subsection 1 of that part designated "§4163."

Further amend said Bill in section 16 by renumbering subsections 2 and 3 of that part designated "§4163." to be subsections 1 and 2.

Further amend said Bill in section 16 by striking out in the 3rd line of subsection 3 (same in L. D.) of that part designated "§4163." the underlined figure 2 and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '1'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 24 the following:

'Sec. 24-A. Department of Conservation. Nothing in this Act shall be interpreted to prevent or affect the exercise of the power vested in the Commissioner of the Department of Conservation to delegate powers, duties, rights and responsibilities with respect to the public lots or other public lands, pursuant to Title 12, section 5014, as

"Forest Commissioner" as used herein shall mean the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands of the Department of Conservation, if, as and when the aforesaid power is exercised.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 2 to 13 and sections 19 to 24.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections of the bill to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment would leave sections 1, 5-A, 14, 16-A, 17, 18 and 25 of the bill, except those portions of sections 15 and 16 authorizing and providing for the sale, exchange, location or relocation of public lots and would add a new section 24-A to coordinate this bill with the Department of Conservation.
