STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Appropriate Additional Matching Funds for Social Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Department of Health and Welfare; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare, the sum of \$1,208,654 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1974 and 1,049,828 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975, to provide state funds to match federal funds estimated to be available for social services. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this appropriation is to provide additional state matching funds for social services to assist Maine people in the areas of employment, self-help and self-care. State funds appropriated will be matched with federal funds at the rate of 3:1, primarily under Title IV-A and XVI of the Social Security Act. This appropriation will assist the State of Maine to take full advantage of the federal dollars available to Maine for social services.
