COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1375, L. D. 1831, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Site Location of Development Act."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Statement of
Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The purpose of this bill is to allow the Board of Environmental
Protection to solicit and receive testimony as to the beneficial
as well as the detrimental effects of a proposed development upon the
public's health, safety and general welfare.'
