COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1376, L. D. 1832, Bill,  
"AN ACT Extending Regulation of Fishing Methods and Quantity and  
Type of Gear Used."

Amend said Bill in the 5th line after the amending clause  
(4th and 5th lines in L. D.) by striking out the underlined  
words "citizens of the State of Maine" and inserting in place  
thereof the underlined word 'persons' and in the 6th line  
(same in L. D.) by striking out the underlined word "citizens"  
and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'persons'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the last 2  
lines before the Statement of Fact (next to last line in L. D.)  
the underlined words 'or within international waters'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this Amendment is to conserve the fish,  
shellfish and lobster industry which exists along the coast of  
Maine by extending the area in which the State's conservation  
laws shall apply, to the extent of the jurisdiction of the  
United States on the marginal sea and high seas, and requiring  
persons licensed by the State of Maine who engage in this  
industry to practice conservation methods in these waters.
