Funds provided for purchase of Water Rights and Dam on Big Ferguson Stream, Somerset County. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Town of Cambridge the sum of \$5,000 to buy the water rights and dam located in the Town of Cambridge on Big Ferguson Stream.

STATEMENT OF FACT
