STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Retirement of Police Officers and Fire Fighters of the
City of Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1121, sub-§ 8, amended. Subsection 8 of section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 288 of the public laws of 1965 and as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

Except that the City of Augusta shall allow retirement after 25 years service at $\frac{2}{3}$ of final current compensation.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 5, § 1121, sub-§ 9, amended. Subsection 9 of section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 143 of the public laws of 1967 and as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

Except that the City of Augusta shall allow retirement after 25 years service at $\frac{2}{3}$ of final current compensation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title.
