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**AN ACT to Allow Insurance of any Kind to be Sold to All Groups.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 24-A, § 2437, additional.** Title 24-A of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2437 to read as follows:

**§ 2437. Insurance policies issued to groups**

Policies of insurance of any kind authorized by this Title may be issued to groups as provided for in section 2603 to 2610, 2804 to 2808 and 4501 and, in addition, to any groups of individuals organized for the purpose of obtaining group policies of insurance on such terms and at such rates as they may contract for, subject to other applicable provisions of this Title.

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 24-A, § 2602, repealed.** Section 2602 of Title 24-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 132 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed.

**Sec. 3. R. S., T. 24-A, § 2803, repealed.** Section 2803 of Title 24-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 132 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed.
