HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1417, L. D. 1855, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Access and Egress to Great Ponds."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the first paragraph
of that part designated "§3860." of section 2, before the period,
the following:

'except that this provision shall not apply to access or egress over
the land of a water company or a water district when the water from
the great pond is utilized as a source for public water'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow a water company or
water district to protect the source of supply for public water.
