HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 591, L.D. 1863, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend Definitions in Ambulance Service Licensing."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'4. Ambulance service. "Ambulance service" means any organization or any person or persons setting-themselves-forth-as providing- who routinely provide emergency first aid care or transportation for ill or injured persons to anyone within a geographic area upon request.'

The purpose of this amendment is to further clarify the definition of ambulance service.
