STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Permit Fees for Automobile Graveyards or Junkyards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 30, § 2455, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 2455 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 3 of chapter 481 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:
- 2. Within 100 feet from highway. Five Two hundred dollars for each permit for an automobile graveyard or junkyard located within 100 feet from any highway, plus the cost of posting and publishing said notice.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This legislation is to revise the existing law because the Supreme Judicial Court, sitting as a law court on March 15, 1973, found the \$500 permit fee to be discriminatory and arbitrary, thus invalid and unconstitutional.
