COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 592, L. D. 1869, Bill,
"AN ACT to Institute a Priority Program Budget System."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Intent. The Members of the 106th Legislature endorse the concept of a priority program budget system, as an effective procedure to improve the preparation, analysis, implementation and administration of the fiscal operations of the State.

Sec. 2. Assistance. All department heads, bureau chiefs and other state officials responsible for budget preparation are directed to assist by all means possible the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs and any special committees that may be formed by the executive for the consideration and implementation of the priority program budget system.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to record the support of the Legislature for the priority program budget system.
