STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Membership on the Maine School Building Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 3504, amended. The 2nd to the 7th sentences of section 3504 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The Maine School Building Authority shall consist of the 9 members of the State Board of Education and the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 20, § 3504, amended. The next to the last sentence of the first paragraph of section 3504 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Five Six members of the authority shall constitute a quorum and the affirmative vote of ± 5 members shall be necessary for any action taken by the authority.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 20, § 3504, amended. The last paragraph of section 3504 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 22 of chapter 610 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended to read as follows:

All members of the authority shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties and all members, except the Governor and the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services, shall receive, in addition, \$10 per day for services actually rendered.
