IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Prohibition Against Hitchhiking.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2188, amended. The first sentence of section 2188 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person while upon the traveled portion of any public highway or the right of way of any public highway to endeavor by words, gestures or otherwise, to beg, invite or secure transportation in any motor vehicle not engaged in passenger carrying for hire, unless said person knows the driver thereof or any passenger therein.
