COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1460, L. D. 1885, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Illuminated Advertisements on Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined sentence before the Statement of Fact (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following: 'This section shall not apply to the illuminated name and telephone number identifications affixed to vehicles used for the conveyance of passengers.'
