

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1461, L.D. 1886, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Willful Killing or Injury to Certain Animals."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "<u>§1092</u>" by striking out the last 4 underlined sentences before the Emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The court shall order the person convicted of such a crime to make restitution to the owner thereof of the fair market value for any animal so killed, wounded, maimed, disfigured or poisoned, except as provided in Title 7, section 3602. If the person convicted cannot pay, as ordered, the court may place him on probation until such sentence is fully performed. Such probation may commence as ordered by the court. If he is sentenced to the State Prison or a correctional center, one condition of parole shall be restitution.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is intended to provide method of restitution to a person who has his animal killed illegally by another.
