
SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1478, L.D. 1903, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Solid Waste Disposal."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§1308." by adding at
the end a new sentence to read as follows:

'Landscape refuse and fill disposal sites established in connection
with public works projects and commonly known as "stump dumps" are
exempt from this chapter.'
