HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 613, L. D. 1916, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 53 in that part designated "§ 1259-A." in subsection 3 (same in L.D.) by striking out all of the last underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Such persons shall be named by the clerk prior to the election and the total number from the voting districts shall be as evenly divided as possible between the political parties.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to designate who shall name the persons who count absentee ballots.
