HOUSE AMENDMENT " D" to S. P. 613, L. D. 1916, Bill,

Amend said Bill in section 51 in the 10th and 11th lines  
(8th, 9th and 10th lines in L. D.) by striking out the underlined  
punctuation and words ", except in those municipalities where  
the municipal officers have authorized the clerk to process  
absentee ballots"
