SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1490, L.D. 1918, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Certain Ambiguities in the Chiropractic Licensing Law and to Revise Certain Provisions Relating to the Board of Chiropractic Examination and Registration."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 1 and 2.

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by inserting in the 5th line from the end (same in L.D.) after the underlined word "agency" the following underlined words: 'which agency has been approved by the board'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 3 to 6 to be sections 1 to 4.
