## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 622, L.D. 1936, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to School Buses."

Amend said Bill in section 4 in paragraph E of that part designated "§2013." by striking out in the 4th and 5th lines of paragraph E (4th line of L.D.) the following underlined words: "shall be filed within 10 days after" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words: 'and all requirements for application, examination and certification shall be satisfactorily completed prior to'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2013." by striking out all of subsection 2.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for examination and certification of school bus operators prior to commencement of operation and does away with exemptions for substitute or occasional drivers.
