HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 622, L.D. 1936, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to School Buses."

Amend said Bill in section 4 in paragraph E of that part
designated "§2013." by striking out in the 4th and 5th lines
of paragraph E (4th line of L.D.) the following underlined words:
"shall be filed within 10 days after" and inserting in place
thereof the following underlined words: 'and all requirements
for application, examination and certification shall be
satisfactorily completed prior to'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2013."
by striking out all of subsection 2.

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for examination and certification
of school bus operators prior to commencement of operation and
does away with exemptions for substitute or occasional drivers.
