HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to S. P. 622, L. D. 1936, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to School Buses."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated
"§2020." of section 4 and inserting in place thereof the following:
'§2020. Exception

Buses which are operated by a mass transit authority or are
operated by a motor carrier holding a certificate of public convenience
from the Public Utilities Commission, while transporting school
children, shall be exempted from the provisions of this subchapter.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt transit type
buses from the provisions of this bill.
