HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1523, L. D. 1953, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Regulation and Inspection of Plumbing."

Amend said Bill in section 8 in that part designated
" §3305." by striking out all of subsection 3 (same in L.D.)
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'3. Private owners. Nothing in this chapter shall prevent
a person from plumbing on any property owned, controlled or
leased by that person.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to exempt owners of
property from the provisions of the Act.
