HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 630,
L.D. 1956, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Mobile Home Parks."

Amend said Amendment in that part designated "§4065."
by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

'This section shall not apply to a mobile home park which operates
a centralized distribution system for oil or gas, or both.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt from the restrictions
on the purchase of fuel oil or bottled gas a mobile home park which
has a centralized distribution system.
