HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 630,
L. D. 1956, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Mobile Home Parks."

Amend said Amendment in that part designated "§4065."
by adding at the end 2 new sentences to read as follows:
'This section shall not apply to a mobile home park owner or
operator who provides a centralized distribution system for fuel
oil or bottled gas, or both, for residents therein. No mobile
home park owner or operator who provides such a centralized
distribution system shall charge residents more than the average
retail price charged by other retail distributors for fuel oil or
bottled gas in the county in which the mobile home park is located.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt from the restrictions
on the purchase of fuel oil or bottled gas a mobile home park which
has a centralized distribution system, but to regulate the prices
charged for such oil and gas.
