STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Medical Treatment of Persons at State Operated Facilities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, § 2706, additional. Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2706, to read as follows:

§ 2706. Treatment at state operated facilities

No person shall diagnose, profess or attempt to diagnose, cure or relieve, or attempt to cure or relieve, any human disease, ailment, defect or complaint of physical origin by attendance or advice, prescribing or furnishing any drug, medicine, appliance, manipulation method or any therapeutic agent whatsoever at any institution or facility operated by the State, unless licensed and duly qualified to practice under this chapter or Title 32, chapter 48.

No person shall cure or relieve or attempt to cure or relieve the physical symptoms of any human disease, ailment, defect or complaint of mental origin by attendance or advice, prescribing or furnishing any drug, medicine, appliance, manipulation method or any therapeutic agent whatsoever at any institution or facility operated by the State, unless licensed and duly qualified to practice under this chapter or Title 32, chapter 48.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 32, § 3295, additional. Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3295, to read as follows:

§ 3295. Treatment at state operated facilities

No person shall diagnose, profess or attempt to diagnose, cure or relieve, or attempt to cure or relieve, any human disease, ailment, defect or complaint of physical origin by attendance or advice, prescribing or furnishing any drug, medicine, appliance, manipulation method or any therapeutic agent whatsoever at any institution or facility operated by the State, unless licensed and duly qualified to practice under this chapter or Title 32, chapter 37.

No person shall cure or relieve or attempt to cure or relieve the physical symptoms of any human disease, ailment, defect or complaint of mental origin by attendance or advice, prescribing or furnishing any drug, medicine, appliance, manipulation method or any therapeutic agent whatsoever at any institution or facility operated by the State, unless licensed and duly qualified to practice under this chapter or Title 32, chapter 37.
