IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Clarify the Definition of Misconduct under the Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 26, § 1043, sub-§ 23, repealed and replaced. Subsection 23 of section 1043 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 5 of chapter 381 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 23. Misconduct. The term "misconduct" shall mean, but not be limited to, repeated absenteeism or tardiness after notice or warning, insubordination without provocation by the employer or his agent or disregard of the employer's interest, rules or regulations.
