Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 3rd, 4th and 5th paragraphs from the end, before the Statement of Fact, and inserting in place thereof the following:

'From January 1, 1974 it shall be unlawful for any person
holding a lobster and crab fishing license to fish more than 600
lobster traps or pots.'

The purpose of this amendment is to limit fisherman to 600 traps.
