HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1545, L. D. 1976, Bill,
"AN ACT Creating York County Commissioner Districts."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§ 105-0." by striking out all of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th
paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Commissioner District number 1, consisting of the
municipalities of Arundel, Eliot, Kennebunk, Kennebunkport,
Kittery, South Berwick, Wells and York;

Commissioner District number 2, consisting of the
municipalities of Acton, Alfred, Berwick, Buxton, Cornish,
Dayton, Hollis, Lebanon, Limerick, Limington, Lyman, Newfield,
North Berwick, Parsonsfield, Sanford, Shapleigh and Waterboro;

Commissioner District number 3, consisting of the
municipalities of Biddeford, Old Orchard Beach and Saco.'

The purpose of this amendment will set up more geographically
centered and equally populist districts.
