HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to S. P. 642, L. D. 1977, Bill, "AN ACT
Creating a Study Commission on Environmental Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the next to the last
line of the first paragraph the words "and the 13 members"
and inserting in place thereof the words 'the 13 members'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the period at the
end of the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'and the following persons who shall serve on the commission
in an advisory capacity only: The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries
and Game; the Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries; the Commissioner
of Parks and Recreation; the Forestry Commissioner and the Attorney
General.'

agencies who are equally concerned with environmental laws.
