SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 642, L. D. 1977, Bill,
"AN ACT Creating a Study Commission on Environmental Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. Purpose and intent. The environment of the State of Maine is of primary importance to the citizens of Maine.

Various laws have been passed to protect the environment, which may have overlapping and conflicting provisions. A study should be instituted to the end that the citizens of Maine have their environment protected to the greatest possible degree without precluding reasonable and compatible development.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 and 2 to be sections 2 and 3.
