HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1565, L.D. 1999, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Jury Commissioners and County Officers in the Several Counties of the State and Court Messenger of Cumberland County and Payments to the County Law Libraries."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 3 a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in the event Phase

II and III in any other federal order regulating pay increases

or incentives are rescinded or repealed, the county commissioners

may increase salaries of statutory and constitutional officers to

the amount approved by the commissioners and approved by the majority

of the legislative delegation as submitted by budget to the 106th

Legislature in January 1973.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to provide salary increases for county officers as submitted to the 106th Legislature in the event federal restrictions are relaxed.
