

STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "C " to H.P. 1565, L.D. 1999, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Jury Commissioners and County Officers in the Several Counties of the State and Court Messenger of Cumberland County and Payments to the County Law Libraries."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause, the following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to adjust salaries of jury commissioners and county officers; and

Whereas, such adjustments are needed at the earliest possible moment to meet the ever-increasing costs of living; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 4 a new section 5 to read as follows:

'Sec. 5. Effective date. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 30, section 3, this Act shall become effective July 1, 1973.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following emergency clause:

(Filing no. H- 513)

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect July 1 1973.'
