

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 1565, L.D. 1999, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Jury Commissioners and County Officers in the Several Counties of the State and Court Messenger of Cumberland County and Payments to the County Law Libraries."

Amend said Bill by adding after section 3 a new section 3-A to read as follows:

'Sec. 3-A. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. Section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

Notwithstanding the previous paragraph, all fees and charges of whatever nature, including charges for the publication of notices required by law, which may be payable to any Cumberland county officer, shall be payable by them to the Cumberland county treasurer for the use and benefit of the county, but preserving the right of the sheriff and his deputies to receive fees for service of civil process and of his deputies not on a salary or per diem basis to receive fees for service of criminal process, and no Cumberland county officer shall receive a private benefit from the labor of any person in the employ of Cumberland County.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for fees and charges of Cumberland county officers.
