

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "G" to H. P. 1565, L. D. 1999, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Jury Commissioners and County Officers in the Several Counties of the State and Court Messenger of Cumberland County and Payments to the County Law Libraries."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out all of the 6th paragraph (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'<u>Hancock County</u>: County commissioners, \$1,900 \$2,400; chairman, \$2,200 \$2,700; clerk of courts, \$5,250 \$5,750; deputy clerk of courts, \$4,100; county attorney, \$8,500; assistant county attorney, \$4,500; county treasurer, \$4,000 \$4,500; sheriff, \$6,500 \$7,000; register of deeds, \$5,250 \$5,750; judge of probate, \$5,250 \$5,750; register of probate, \$5,250 \$5,750;'

The purpose of this amendment is to increase each of the county salaries in Hancock County \$500.
