
SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1581, L. D. 2007, Bill,
"AN ACT to Adjust Certain Salary Provisions of State Officers
and Officials."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before the Emergency
clause the following:

'Sec. 7. Application. The salary increases herein provided
shall not apply to any District Court Judge who shall have been
a member of the 106th Legislature prior to being appointed and
who shall have been appointed during the 1973-74 biennium.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that any salary
increases to any District Court Judge shall not apply to any
member of the 106th Legislature who may be appointed as a
District Court Judge.
