SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 635, L.D. 2008, Bill, "AN ACT Reconstituting and More Effectively Coordinating the Maine Commission on Drug Abuse and the Division of Alcoholism and Providing an Alternative Sentencing for Violators of Drug Laws."

Amend said Bill in SUBCHAPTER II in that part designated "§7106." by striking out in the 15th line of subsection 4 (13th and 14th lines of L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation "criminal justice,"

Further amend said Bill in SUBCHAPTER II in that part designated "§7106." by striking out in the 16th line of subsection 4 (14th line of L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation "law enforcement,"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate a conflict of the proposed office with the already established functions of the Maine Law Enforcement Planning and Assistance Agency under the Federal Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 as amended.
